

BLOCK OF THE MONTH – June 2020
HOME SWEET HOME (aka Quarantine Quarters)

Use scraps of your choice for house construction, EXCEPT for sides and roof corners, use white.

Roof Fabric - Cut: one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

House Siding Fabric – Cut: two – $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
three – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
four – $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
four – $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Windows Fabric – Cut: two – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
two – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Door Fabric – Cut: one – $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle

Sides & Roof Corners Fabric - Cut: two - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
(white) two – $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Diagram 1: Roof Unit: Mark a diagonal line on wrong side of each white $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Align marked white squares with the ends of the roof fabric. Sew on marked lines; trim excess fabric, leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

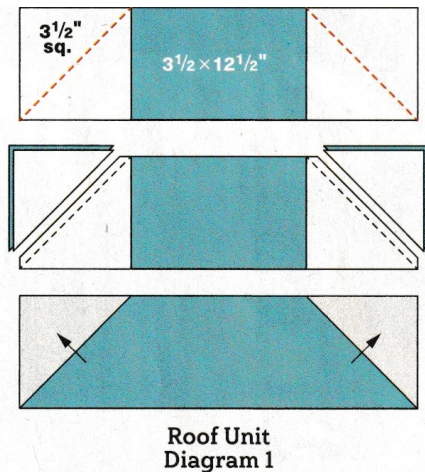
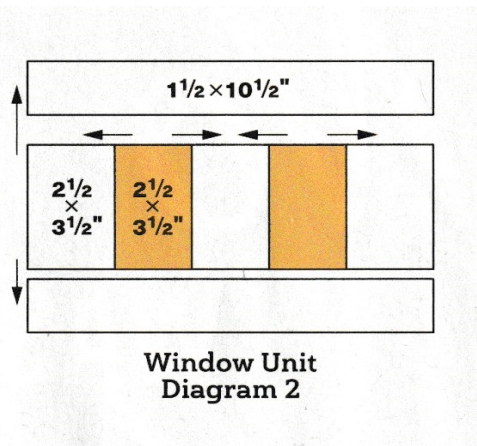


Diagram 2: Upper Story Window Unit: Alternate $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " siding fabric with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " window fabric. Add $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " siding fabric rectangles.



Diagrams 3 & 4: Door Unit: Sew remaining siding fabric to 2 1/2" square window fabric as shown. Sew those sub-units to the door fabric as shown.

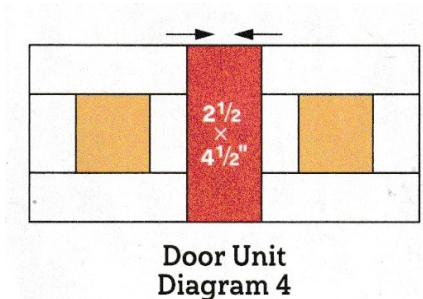
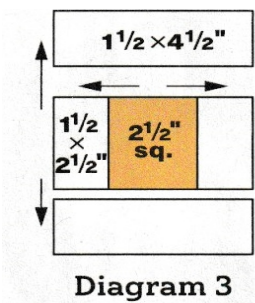
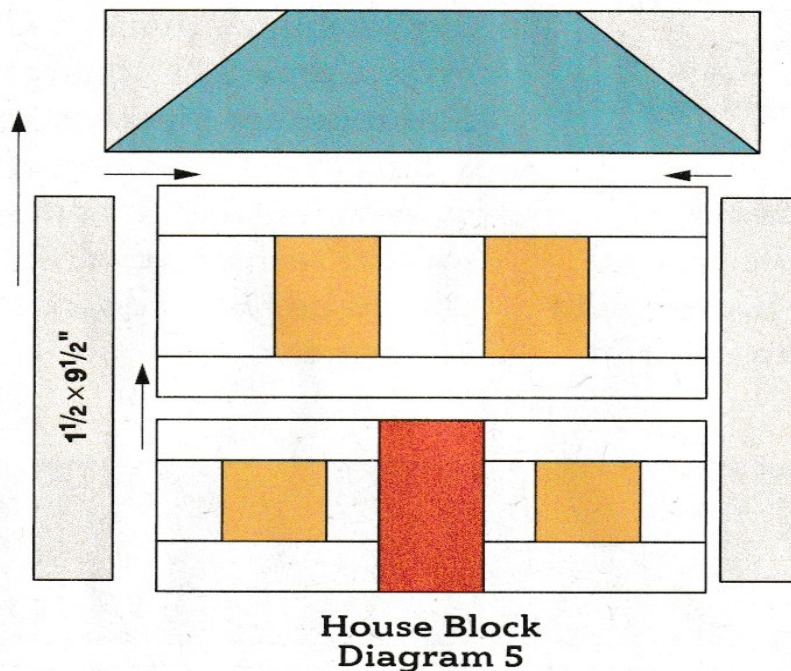


Diagram 5: House Block: Join the upper story window and door units. Then add the side (white) fabric rectangles. Finally, add the roof unit.



Your block should measure 12 1/2" square (unfinished).
