MEETINGS and MEMBERSHIP

Meetings are held on the second Sunday of each month at the Bayside Fire Station. Members are encouraged to arrive by 1:00, and the meeting begins at 1:15 p.m. Activities include guild business, Block of the Month, door prizes, Show and Tell and other activities. A fat quarter theme is selected each month for a drawing. Members volunteer to bring refreshments.

Dues are \$25 per year. The membership year runs July – June to coincide with our fiscal year. Guests/visitors are asked to join the guild after attending two meetings.

SEWING DAYS

The guild reserves the Bayside Fire Station meeting room for monthly meetings and all-day sews. Dates and times are listed in the newsletter. It's a great time for beginners to come and get tips from experienced quilters. Since the guild has the room for the entire day, members often come early and stay late to work on projects.

QUILT SHOW

The first annual quilt show was held in September, 1994. It has been a successful and anticipated event each year. This is the Guild's annual fundraiser and proceeds are used for quilt teachers, comfort quilts, block of the month, and other guild supplies. A guilt is raffled each year; the member whose quilt is voted Best in Show is given the honor and choice of making the raffle quilt for the show held in 2 years. Quilts may be entered by members to sell or show, and each member is asked to submit a small quilt for the Silent Auction. A bazaar table is also available for cash/carry sales of guilting related items such as pattern books, pieces of fabric, small guilted items or larger guilts not entered in the voting categories. The guild keeps a percentage from the sale of quilts sold during the show and bazaar table plus all proceeds from the Silent Auction.

The guild tries to bring teachers to Kodiak each year for classes. We also encourage our talented members within our group to teach classes in their personal specialties.
