

COMFORT QUILT GUIDELINES

Kodiak Bear Paw Quilters Guild has been providing Comfort Quilts for over 20 years. These quilts are made by members to be used by those in our community and beyond who might need a hug. Recipients are nominated by someone telling a Guild member. Quilts are currently being stored at Sandy Peotter's house until they are needed. Quilters are encouraged to help deliver the quilt to the recipient when finished.

Currently the Guild participates in the following ongoing projects. As the need arises the Guild members have made a donation to various one-time projects, such as the 100 pillow cases made for the youth of the Paradise Fire in California to be used as their book bags.

- 1) Comfort quilts have been from baby size to twin and anything in between.
- 2) Infusion quilts we provide to Providence Infusion Center are lap sized quilts.
- 3) Elder House quilts are either twin or lap size. New residents can request colors and size for their quilt. A guild member coordinates the request for a quilt and the membership identifies a member willing to make the quilt.
- 4) Quilts of Valor (QOV) are made by guild members who have joined our KBPQ QOV subgroup. The national foundation has specific guidelines for size limits, fabric and donation of quilting. Minimum size is 55" x 65" Maximum is 72" x 90". Visit <https://www.QOVF.org> for more information.

The Guild has a stash of donated fabric which members may use for the top, backing or binding on all categories of comfort quilts. Fabric donations are always welcome. MEMBERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO DONATE MATERIALS FOR THE QUILTS AS THEY ARE ABLE.

TOPS: 100% cotton fabric usually provided by the quilter or Guild stash. Occasionally packets of coordinated fabrics are available for members to take home to complete. A completed top can be turned in at a Guild meeting.

BACKING AND BINDING: Can be cotton,, flannel, or minke. Sources: Guild provided donated or new fabric, discounted reimbursement if backing fabric is from your stash, or total reimbursement for new fabric if receipt is provided.

BATTING: Guild will reimburse the quilter. Currently the Guild has a roll of batting to provide for comfort quilts. Pick it up during a meeting before taking the quilt to a long arm quilter.

QUILTING: Guild will reimburse members for quilting. The pattern should be a simple all over one.
